

## GENERAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION FOR 2025-2026 BUDGET RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF CHARLOTTE PUBLIC SCHOOLS ADOPTED JUNE 23, 2025

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be the general appropriations of Charlotte Public Schools for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026. A resolution to make appropriations; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of all income received by Charlotte Public Schools. Furthermore, the appropriations include the levy of the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, to be used for general operating expenditures of the district, 7.59 debt mills, and 0.4958 mill for playground and recreation programming.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total revenues and unappropriated fund balance estimated to be available for appropriations in the General Fund of Charlotte Public Schools for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 is as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized to make budgetary transfers within the line items of appropriation centers established through this budget and that all transfers between appropriations listed in this resolution may be made only by further action of the Board of Education, pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Uniform Accounting and Budgeting Act.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that no Board of Education member or employee of the school district shall expend any funds or obligate the expenditure of any funds except pursuant to appropriations made by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board. Changes in the amount appropriated by the Board shall require approval by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of Schools is hereby charged with general supervision of the execution of the budget adopted by the Board and shall hold administrators, supervisors, department heads, and teachers responsible for performance of their responsibilities within the amounts appropriated by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board. This appropriation resolution is to take effect, July 1, 2025.
